The primary purpose of the **Community Foundation Scholarship Program** is to support the educational efforts of the community, families and individuals and in particular those in need through financial assistance for educational programs.

Scholarship Guidelines

Scholarships are awarded to students currently enrolled in Santiago Canyon College who are transferring their college credits and enrolling in Chapman University in Orange, California.

Scholarships will range between \$500 and \$1000 per year.

Scholarship Requirements

- Individual applicants must be graduates of high schools within the Orange Unified School District boundaries, or be legal residents of Orange, California.
- Individual applicants must be enrolled in Santiago Canyon College in Orange, California.
- Applicants must be enrolled in classes equating to 12 or more units.
- Applicants must apply for and be granted admission to Chapman University.
- Applicants must demonstrate Community Service Involvement
- Applicants must maintain a 3.0 grade point average and submit recent (unofficial) transcript with application.
- Scholarships for individuals will generally not be approved more than once.

Application Deadlines

Applications should be postmarked on or before April 1, 2011 for the Fall 2011 and by October 31, 2011 for the Spring 2012 semester to allow time for the local review process.
